Through Caesarea, Megiddo and the Druze Villages see the excavations of the Crusader City and the Roman Port, aqueduct and the amphitheater that has been restored to its former glory as a concert venue. Travel from Mount Carmel to Haifa for a panoramic view of the Haifa Bay and golden-domed Bahai Shrine and Gardens. Overnight in a Kibbutz Guesthouse. Stop at the Golan Winery for a tour and wine tasting; in Nazareth see the Church of the Annunciation.
