### Ancient Geoglyphs & Abundant Marine Life

Located on the southern coast of Peru, Nazca and Paracas are surrounded by deserts landscapes. From Lima, travel by bus to Paracas, a small port town. Check into your hotel. Witness one of the world's greatest archaeological mysteries with a 90 minute flight over the ancient geoglyphs and geometric lines in the **Nazca Desert**. Ancient depictions of animals and plants can reach up to 300 meters in length and occupy an area of 1,000 m<sup>2</sup>. Overnight at Doubletree Resort by Hilton Hotel Paracas. After breakfast, enjoy a morning visit to the Paracas National Reserve, boasting one of the highest concentrations of marine birds on the planet. Return to Lima.




