Begin your morning tour of Palermo, a city full of character, featuring Quattro Canti, a splendid example of Spanish Baroque architecture, the Palace of the Normans and its superb Palatine Chapel, the Cathedral, the famous Benedictine Abbey of

Monreale and admire a 12th-century cathedral. Take the rest of the day to relax or take an optional tour with your tour director to the picturesque fishing village of Cefalù. SEGESTA, MARSALA, TRAPANI Buffet breakfast at your hotel. Visit a wine cellar and sample Marsala during a special wine tasting session. Drive along the Trapani coastline and stop for a special Sicilian lunch in a restaurant and return to Palermo. Day 5 – Tuesday

Take an optional tour featuring the authentic villages chosen by Francis Ford Coppola for most of the scenes in the Godfather movies, a great way to explore the real untouched Sicilian countryside, local lifestyle and culture.
