

8 DAYS

During your 8-day journey, travel from Split to Dubrovnik with a stop in Kotor, Montenegro.

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# Day 1

SPLIT Arrival in the Croatian city of Split, located on the Eastern shores of the Adriatic Sea. Welcome by our local representative and transfer to your hotel. Marmont Hotel Heritage, Standard

# Day 2

SPLIT After breakfast at the hotel, take a guided morning tour of Split. Uncover the secrets of this city built around the Diocletian Palace where locals sought refuge centuries ago. Wander through its charming little streets; see the Peristyle, Jupiter's Temple and the cathedral. Enjoy your afternoon at leisure. Marmont Hotel Heritage

SPLIT - HVAR After breakfast, transfer by catamaran to Hvar, queen of the Croatian Dalmatian Islands, famous since antiquity. Thanks to its mild climate with warm winters and pleasant summers, Hvar receives many guests, scientists and travellers who are attracted by the dense Mediterranean nature, rich tradition, architecture and nightlife. Discover the island on your own; buy some beautiful lavender which is found growing everywhere during the warm summer months; enjoy a glass of posip, a fresh white wine grown on Hvar Island. HVAR - KORCULA After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy your morning at leisure. Take an afternoon catamaran transfer to Korcula, where many believe Marco Polo was born. Overnight in Korcula. Hotel Korsal, Standard Seaview Room ★★★★

KORCULA - DUBROVNIK Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Korcula is one of the greenest and most popular islands in the Adriatic Sea. This walled town offers one of Croatia's most romantic views, narrow streets, beautiful churches and magnificent palaces. Discover this and more during a morning walking tour. Then drive to Ston for lunch at one of its famous oyster restaurants. Continue to the most popular city in the Adriatic, Dubrovnik. Hilton Imperial Dubrovnik, Standard Room ★★★★

## Day 6

DUBROVNIK After breakfast at the hotel, take a morning city tour of Dubrovnik to admire the stunning architecture and sculptural detail of its many monuments and fountains.
