Day 1

COPENHAGEN, DENMARK Welcome to Copenhagen, the colourful and compact capital city of the Kingdom of Denmark and one of Europe's oldest cities. Private transfer to your hotel. The capital is full of attractions, most of them located within walking distance in the city center. Scandic Palace ****

Day 2

COPENHAGEN After breakfast at your hotel, make your way to the meeting point on your own and begin your shared sightseeing tour of Copenhagen offering amazing views of many statues and landmarks including the Tivoli, the Danish Parliament Christiansborg Palace, the Round Tower and the Little Mermaid where you can stop for a photo. Enjoy a visit of the exterior of Amalienborg Palace, residence of kings and queens, where you may witness the changing of the guards. Enjoy the rest of your afternoon exploring the city on your own. Day 3

COPENHAGEN Breakfast at the hotel. Your day is at leisure today. We recommend a visit to the world-famous amusement park at **Tivoli Gardens**^{*} which originally opened in 1843. Perhaps visit the museum of **Carlsberg** or one of the many other museums of art, culture, history and design. Be sure to take some time to enjoy the pedestrian shopping streets of **Stroget** and stop for ice cream at *Kongens Nytorv*, while admiring the tall rigged ships in the canal. *Scandic Palace*

Day 4

COPENHAGEN – STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN Enjoy breakfast and check out of the hotel. Private transfer to the Copenhagen Central Station to board your train to **Stockholm**. Upon arrival, make your way to your hotel, just a short walk from the train station. Stockholm is one of the most beautiful capitals in the world, built on 14 islands connected by 57 bridges. With 750 years of history and rich cultural life, Stockholm offers a wide variety of world-class museums and attractions, many of which can be reached on foot. *Scandic Continental* ****

Day 5

On this 7-day tour of two Scandinavian capitals, discover the rich history and architectural legacies of the Hanseatic League. Visit Denmark's compact and colourful capital of Copenhagen, packed with lovely

Learn the city's history and if possible, stop at Fjällgatan, for a magical view of Stockholm's islands and waters. Later, board a boat departing from Strömkajen, in the center of Stockholm, going out through the peaceful Djurgården canal, passing beautiful and famous buildings and enjoying a fabulous view of the city's skyline, only seen from the water. 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Day 6

STOCKHOLM Breakfast at the hotel. Explore the city on your own today. We recommend a visit to the maritime Vasa Museum, showcasing the impressive warship Vasa which sank on her maiden voyage in 1628 but was salvaged 333 years later in 1961. She has since been restored and can now be seen with her complete rigging at the museum. We also suggest a visit of the famous medieval town, Gamla Stan, with many cafes and shops selling souvenirs, art and handicraft. Scandic Continental
