Ireland is a magical, yet small country with rich history and culture. This tour highlights the essence of everything Irish, perfect for a first-time visit. Arrive in Dublin with two days to explore, then pick up your car rental and begin your self-guided discovery of Ireland's main highlights including Connemara National Park in County Galway, the Cliffs of Moher in County Clare and Killarney National Park among others.

Day 1

DUBLIN Arrival in Dublin. Private transfer from the airport to your centrally located hotel. Take some time to rest and settle in. Included in your package is a Dublin tour with access to a hop-on, hop-off bus to board as you wish over the next two days. Some entrance fees are included with your pass. Brooks Hotel Dublin ****

Day 2

DUBLIN After a full Irish breakfast at your hotel, continue your exploration of Dublin. Suggested sites include a visit to Trinity College to view the beautifully illuminated Book of Kells and the National Museum of Ireland. Other sites to consider are St. Patrick's Cathedral, Ireland's largest church, where Jonathan Swift, author of Gulliver's Travel's, was once Dean. Stop off at the Old Jameson Distillery situated in the old markets area of the city, Smithfield. Learn about the process by which whiskey is made, including a whiskey tasting. Brooks Hotel Dublin

Day 3

DUBLIN - GALWAY After breakfast at your hotel, pick up your automatic transmission Ford Focus (or similar) car rental in downtown Dublin. Depart for County Galway, which lies on the west coast of Ireland. Ross Lake House Hotel

Day 4

CONNEMARA After breakfast, begin exploring Connemara, an area full of contrast, with granite mountains populated only by sheep with hundreds of lakes forming a fisherman's paradise. Its stone walls, small farms, thatched cottages in isolated splendour with its heather covered hills, create an unforgettable scene for all its visitors. Your route takes you from Galway to the lake dotted center of Connemara at Maam Cross. The road continues through the colourful town of Clifden and on through the Irish speaking, low-lying part of Southern Connemara with its countless beautiful lakes. Ross Lake House Hotel

Day 5

GALWAY - KERRY After breakfast, check out of your hotel and depart for Kerry. Travel through the heart of County Clare, the Burren Region, a geological paradise boasting over 2,000

plants and many rare flowers. Continue along the coast of Clare to view the spectacular Cliffs of Moher which form a 200m wall that plunges into the Atlantic Ocean. Continue through the farming countryside of $\ensuremath{\text{Limerick}}$ and on to Kerry for your overnight. Parknasilla Resort & Spa +>

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в RING OF KERRY Enjoy an Irish breakfast at your hotel. Begin a superb tour of the Iveragh Peninsula, taking in spectacular scenery including mountains, peat bogs, lakes and magnificent views of the Atlantic Ocean as you travel along the coast road. Travel through Killorglin, famous for its Puck Fair, then on to Glenbeigh where the cliff road offers panoramic views of the Dingle Peninsula and Dingle Bay. Continue to Cahersiveen and the sea town of Waterville. See Sneem Village, famous for its brightly coloured houses; continue on for superb views

Day 7

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DINGLE PENINSULA & LIMERICK After breakfast, check out of your hotel and depart for a tour of the Dingle Peninsula, known for its extraordinary number of ring forts, high crosses and other ancient monuments. West of Dingle, you will find a genuine Irish-speaking area with the greatest concentration of ancient sites in Kerry. Enjoy the dramatic landscape and views of the Blasket Islands from Slea Head.
