Day 1

LONDON Arrival in **London**, England's capital city set on the River Thames. Private transfer from Heathrow airport to your centrally located hotel. London is one of the world's most visited cities with plenty to see and do. Enjoy your day to explore the city on your own. *Blakemore Hyde Park, Club Room*

Day 2 B/BI

LONDON Breakfast at your hotel. From your designated meeting point, begin your total London experience with a panoramic guided tour of the capital's most well-loved landmarks. Pass the historic Westminster Abbey and other important landmarks. Explore St. Paul's Cathedral*, a towering dome masking a number of tombs, memorials and intricately painted mosaics. Stop for photos outside London's Buckingham Palace and watch the changing of the guards*, dressed in their iconic red outfits and bearskin hats. Have an extended visit of the Tower of London whose history is equally fascinating, gruesome and inspiring. Enjoy a relaxing Thames River boat ride. Finish your day with a flight on the Coca-Cola London Eye, an impressive cantilevered observation wheel 135m above London; you can see Windsor Castle on a clear day! Box lunch is included. Day 3 B

LONDON After breakfast, enjoy your day at leisure to explore the city on your own. Perhaps take in a London Theatre show this evening. Blakemore Hyde Park

Day 4 B

OXFORD & TRADITIONAL COTSWOLD VILLAGES After breakfast, you will be picked up from your hotel to join your full-day small-group tour. Head northwest out of London for the day, travelling through the picturesque countryside before arriving in Oxford, home to the oldest English-speaking university in the world. Explore the precincts of the many colleges; climb one of the vantage points to take in the skyline view. Spend the afternoon touring the beautiful villages of the Cotswolds with their tiny ironstone cottages that have remained unchanged for centuries. Visit Bampton, a village with a long association with traditional Morris

Dancing and magnificent parish church of St. Mary in which many iconic scenes from *Downton Abbey* were filmed. Stop in **Burford**, a small market town with enormous character and a huge history. Finally, make the short journey to **Bibury**. Return to London for overnight. *Blakemore Hyde Park*

Day 5

LONDON - STONEHENGE - EXETER After breakfast, check out of your hotel. Begin your multi-day small-group tour by departing London and travel out to the most famous Neolithic standing stone circle of Stonehenge. Continue to the dramatic south Dorset Coast enjoying panoramic views over white sandy beaches and the natural rock arch of Durdle Door. Enjoy an afternoon here to explore some of the coast before arriving at the historic city of Exeter for two nights. Jurys Inn Exeter, Standard Room *****

Day 6

DARTMOOR - TAVISTOCK Your morning is spent exploring the magnificent wilderness of Dartmoor, the ancient "Clapper Bridge" at Postbridge and the historic market town of Tavistock, home to Sir Francis Drake. Return to Exeter in the early afternoon to explore this Roman town's underground passages, ancient walls, Royal Albert Memorial Museum and famous 12th-century Norman Cathedral. Overnight in Exeter. Day 7 B

GLASTONBURY - BATH - LONDON Head to Glastonbury, a lovely old market town. Glastonbury Tor rises high above the town and has mythical connections with King Arthur and Avalon. Climb the Tor for a spectacular view across three counties or explore the town center with its many independent shops. Continue on to Bath. Enjoy an afternoon of exploring and sightseeing in a town full of relics of its Roman past and famous baths. Return to London for overnight. Blakemore Hyde Park

LONDON - HOME After breakfast, check out of your hotel, private transfer to the airport and begin your journey home.
